Constitution

Article I. Name

We the pinheads of Middlebury College hereby declare that the name of this organization shall be the Middlebury Free Heelers.

Article II. Purpose

The purpose of the Middlebury Free Heelers is as follows:

-) To unite telemark skiers on campus
-) To encourage students and staff to experience the magic of free heel skiing
-) To organize events based around telemark skiing

Article III. Membership

There will be two leadership positions each called a Head Pinhead. They will be elected each spring for the following school year. They must be Middlebury College students. Together they shall function as the treasurer and a liaison to the finance committee. Other duties include organizing events and communicating them to other club members.

Article V. Elections

Elections for the following school year will be held at a spring meeting before March 15. Officers will be elected based on a simple majority vote of the membership. A present quorum of the membership will be 2/3 of the membership.

Article VI. Meetings

There will be one meeting at the beginning of each semester and other meetings may be held as needed for elections and other events. The Head Pinheads will conduct the meetings.

Article VII. Committees

The Head Pinheads may appoint temporary committees as they see fit.

Article VIII. Advisor

The membership will recommend a member of faculty staff to advise the organization.

Article IX. Affiliations

The Middlebury Free Heelers have no current affiliations.

Article X. Ratification
