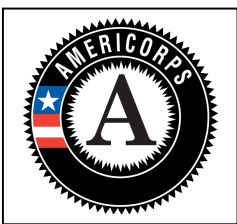


**Make a Difference in Your Community
While Earning Money for College Expenses—
Earn an AmeriCorps Education Award
through SERVE New England.**

From volunteering in an after-school program to sitting on a youth court-diversion board to going on an alternative break trip to work with Habitat for Humanity, your hours can count toward earning an AmeriCorps Education Award. Activities can include the work you are already doing through an off-campus work-study position that meets a community need, service-learning projects, work with student service organizations or groups, individual community volunteer work, service-oriented internships, etc.

How much can you earn?



- 900 hours in 12 or 24 months for an ed award of \$2362.
- 675 hours in 12 months for an ed award of \$1800.
- 450 hours in 12 months for an ed award of \$1250.
- 300 hours in 12 months for an ed award of \$1000.

When you complete your service, you will receive an “ed award” electronic voucher to be applied to future college or graduate school expenses or to pay back student loans. Whether you're working on environmental issues, education or mentoring, public safety, or health—you're out in the community, and you're helping to change lives. We want to support you!
