

## CONSTITUTION FOR THE MISCHORDS

### Article I:

The organization shall be called the Mischords of Middlebury College.

### Article II:

The purpose of the group is to provide singing entertainment to such groups or organizations as desire it.

### Article III:

Members of the Mischords shall be chosen by audition and members shall be female Middlebury College students.

### Article IV: Offices

- A. Leader: the leader of the Mischords shall be chosen in the spring to serve the following year. She shall be chosen by the group on the recommendation of the out-going leader.
- B. Business Manager: the business manager shall be chosen by the group in the spring to serve the following year.

### Article V:

Rehearsal shall be three times a week, or as often as the leader deems necessary, at times agreed upon by all the members.

### Article VI:

The membership may recommend to the President of the College for appointment of a member of the Faculty and/or Staff to act as advisor.

### Article VII:

*This student organization operates in full accordance with Chapter Four, Section II, A of the Middlebury College Handbook concerning Student Organization Policies of Discrimination, Freedom of Association, Anti-Hazing, Freedom of Inquiry and Expression, Student Publication, Funding, Advertising, and Scheduling. Any and all changes made to the Student Organizations Policies section of the Middlebury College Handbook will immediately become policies adopted by the Mischords*

### Article VIII: Ratification

- A. This Constitution has been ratified by a two-third majority of the membership
- B. This Constitution must be approved by the College Council or a subcommittee thereof.

### Article IX: Amendment

- A. Amendments to this Constitution must be approved by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
- B. Amendments to this Constitution must be approved by the College Council or a subcommittee thereof.
