

Middlebury Triathlon Club Constitution

- Article I Name:
The name of this organization shall be the Middlebury Triathlon Club.
- Article II Purpose
The purpose of the organization is as follows:
1. Provide members with an opportunity to compete in triathlons
2. Organize small-scale events
3. Provide training opportunities for members
- Article III Membership: Membership is open to all Middlebury College students.
- Article IV Officers:
A. Officers must be Middlebury College students.
B. President: Leadership and organization of meetings, travel, and training.
C. Treasurer: liaison between the organization and the SGA Finance Committee.
- Article V Elections:
A. Elections will be held in the last week of February.
B. Election meeting must have at least one half of members present and election results will be chosen by a majority vote (51%). Members are defined as those students actively participating in races, training or meetings from the preceding fall and the months of January and February.
- Article VI Meetings: Monthly meetings.
- Article VII Committees: None. President may appoint committee if necessary.
- Article VIII Faculty Advisor: The membership recommends a member of faculty/staff to advise this organization.
- Article IX Affiliations: Organization is a member of the Collegiate Triathlon Association. Individual members must be licensed by USA triathlon for races.
- Article X Ratification:
A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.
- Article X Amendment:
A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
