

MIDDLEBURY COLLEGE MEN'S VOLLEYBALL CLUB

- Article I The name of this organization shall be the Middlebury College Men's Volleyball Club.
- Article II The purpose of the Middlebury College Men's Volleyball Club is as follows:
1. To offer an option for men to play organized volleyball at a competitive level in an intercollegiate arena.
2. To offer instruction and competitive play to those who are interested but have never previously played volleyball.
- Article III Membership is open to all male Middlebury College students.
- Article IV Officers must be Middlebury College students.
The following shall serve as the inaugural officers:
PRESIDENT
The president's role will be to act as the formal liaison between the Middlebury College Men's Volleyball Club and the New England Collegiate Volleyball League.
CO-CAPTAIN (x2)
The Co-Captains' role will be to work with the Athletic Department on a weekly basis to find available practice times and space. The Co-Captains will coach the Club during practices and at tournaments. They will make all game decisions such as who will start.
TREASURER
The treasurer's role will be to act as the formal liaison between the Middlebury College Men's Volleyball Club and the SGA Finance Committee. The treasurer will also be in charge of all fundraising events.
- Article V Elections for all positions will occur annually, be open to all members (defined as those who have participated in one half of previous events, or those who have been awarded member status in previous years), and be decided on a plurality basis. In order for the results to stand, at least half of the members must have participated. In the event of a tie, the faculty adviser will determine the winner. All elections must be completed by March 15th. If an officer drops out mid-term, re-elections for that position will occur the following week.
- Article VI Meetings will consist of two 2-hour practices twice a week and 2-3 weekend tournaments at other colleges per year. Practices will begin in the fall and end with Spring break.
- Article VII No standing committees exist. Therefore, the president of the organization will appoint temporary committees as the need arises.
- Article VIII The membership agrees to maintain an adviser from the faculty or staff, as required.
- Article IX We are affiliated with the New England Collegiate Volleyball League (NECVL).

Article X This student organization operates in full accordance with Chapter Four, Section II, A of the Middlebury College Handbook concerning Student Organization Policies of Discrimination, Freedom of Association, Anti-Hazing, Freedom of Inquiry and Expression, Student Publication, Funding, Advertising, and Scheduling. Any and all changes made to the Student Organizations Policies section of the Middlebury College Handbook will immediately become policies adopted by the Middlebury College Men's Club Volleyball Club.

Article XI A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.

Article XII A. The constitution must be amended by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.
