

Senior Class Social Committee Constitution

Article I: The name of this organization shall be the Middlebury College Senior Class Social Committee.

Article II: The purpose of this Committee is to promote Senior Class spirit, solidarity, and unity through the organization of various social events.

Article III: Membership is open to all members of the Middlebury College Senior Class.

Article IV: The officers shall consist of two Chairpersons (one male and one female). Their duties shall include the convening of all meetings, and the organization of all events. The officers must be students of Middlebury College.

Article V: Officers shall be appointed at the end of the Spring Semester. These officers shall convene the first meeting of the following fall. These appointments must then be ratified by a two-thirds of the membership.

Article VI: Meetings shall be convened as necessity dictates (approximately one per week). All meetings are open to all members of the Senior Class.

Article VII: The Officers will appoint temporary committees as the need arises.

Article VIII: This committee will be advised by a staff member of the Student Activities Office.

Article IX: Ratification - A. This constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership. B. This constitution must be approved by the Community Council or a subcommittee thereof.

Article X: Amendments - A. Amendments to this constitution must be approved by a two-thirds majority of the membership. B. Amendments to this constitution must be approved by the Community Council or a sub-committee thereof.
