

# Mamajamas

- Article I The name of the organization shall be the Mamajamas.
- Article II The purpose of the organization is as follows:  
1. To write, learn, and sing a cappella arrangements,  
2. To provide the Middlebury campus with entertainment,  
3. To add another singing group to expand options on campus, and  
4. We do not limit our style in music to a certain type.
- Article III Membership is open to all Middlebury College students by audition.
- Article IV Officers of the Mamajamas must be Middlebury College students. *The following positions must be filled at all times:*  
Musical Director: Rehearsal preparation, teaching, direction, and concert direction  
Business Manager: Off campus scheduling, budgeting, and transportation  
General Manager: On campus communication, administration logistics, rehearsal scheduling, on campus concert scheduling (location/time), CCAL liaison  
  
*The following positions will be filled when applicable:*  
Album Producer: Recording preparation, click tracks, finale organization, and recording liaison  
Alumni Relations: Alumni contact, reunion coordinator  
Historian: Catalogue history of group  
Public Relations: Create posters, emails, and advertisements for events
- Article V Elections shall be held once a year at the end of spring semester, but before March 15<sup>th</sup>, by a two-thirds majority vote, and seventy-five percent quorum of active members.
- Article VI Members shall meet for one hour and thirty minutes three times a week to learn and review music for upcoming performances and/or recordings. More time shall be allotted around performance time if needed.
- Article VII The Musical Director may appoint temporary committees if the need arises.
- Article VIII The membership agrees to maintain an adviser from the Middlebury College faculty or staff, as required.
- Article IX The Mamajamas have no affiliations.
- Article X This student organization operates in full accordance with Chapter Four, Section II, A of the Middlebury College Handbook concerning Student Organization Policies of Discrimination, Freedom of Association, Anti-Hazing, Freedom of Inquiry and Expression, Student Publication, Funding, Advertising, and Scheduling. Any and all changes made to the Student Organizations Policies

section of the Middlebury College Handbook will immediately become policies adopted by the Mamajamas.

Article XI Ratification:

- A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
- B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.

Article XII Amendment:

- A. The constitution must be amended by a two-thirds majority of the membership
- B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.
