Directions

From NY and Points West:

Take I-87 (Northway) North to Exit 20. Go East on Rt. 149 to Rt. 4 into Vermont. At Exit 4 (Castleton, VT) take Rt. 30 North to Middlebury. The Athletic Center will be on your right.

From Rutland and Points South:

Take Route 7 North to Middlebury. Then take Route 30 to the Athletic Center, it will be on your left.

From Woodstock and Points East:

Take Route 4 West to Route 7 (Rutland). Go North on Route 7 to Middlebury. Then take Route 30 to the Athletic Center, it will be on your left.

From Burlington, VT and Points North:

Take Route 7 South to Middlebury. Then take Route 30 to the Athletic Center, it will be on your left.
