# ARCHITECTURE TABLE CONSTITUTION

- Article I      Name: The name of this organization shall be Architecture Table.
- Article II      Purpose: The purpose of the Architecture Table is to expand the role of architecture in forming and supporting contemporary culture. Through weekly discussions, frequent field trips, occasional guest lectures and annual social events, Architecture Table seeks to provoke creative thought and foster critical dialogue concerning the built environment.
- Article III      Membership: Membership must be open to all Middlebury College students, alumni, faculty and staff.
- Article IV      Officers: There shall be three officers:  
President (Chair) – The Chair is the public face of Architecture Table. The chair will organize Table events and delegate responsibilities.  
Treasurer (Stool) – The Stool will manage all Table funds and serve as liaison between Architecture Table and the SGA Finance Committee.  
Chaplain (Cloth) – the Cloth will ensure that the intellectual, spiritual and literal bellies of the Architecture Table is full at all times.
- Article V      Elections: The above officers will be determined by a biannual election, the results of which must be determined before November 15<sup>th</sup> (for the Spring officers) and March 15<sup>th</sup> (for the Fall). Elections shall be conducted only when there is a quorum, which shall be 2/3 of active members. One must receive a simple majority of votes in order to be elected.
- Article VI      Meetings: Meetings will be held weekly at the lunch session of Architecture.
- Article VII      Committees: The Architecture Table Chair shall appoint committees as appropriate.
- Article VIII      Faculty Advisor: The membership recommends a member of the faculty to advise the organization.
- Article IX      Affiliations: Architecture Table is not currently affiliated with any local or regional organization.
- Article X      Discrimination Policy: This student organization operates in full accordance with Chapter Four, Section II, A of the *Middlebury College Handbook* concerning Student Organization Policies of Discrimination, Freedom of Association, Anti-Hazing, Freedom of Inquiry and Expression, Student Publication, Funding, Advertising, and Scheduling. Any and all changes made to the Student Organizations Policies section of the *Middlebury College Handbook* will immediately become policies adopted by the Architecture Table.
- Article XI      Ratification:  
A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.  
B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.
- Article XII      Amendment:  
A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.  
B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Constitution Committee.
