

Co-ed Water Polo Club

- Article I. Name
The name of this organization shall be the Middlebury College Co-ed Water Polo Club.
- Article II. Purpose
The purpose of this organization is to supply students at Middlebury College with an opportunity to participate in competitive water polo. The importance of sound physical health through participation in a lifelong sport such as swimming will also be stressed.
- Article III. Membership
Membership is open to all students at Middlebury College.
- Article IV. Offices
There shall be six officers: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Social Chair, Keeper of the Flame, and General Secretary. The President and Vice President are responsible for organizing games, tournaments, and league membership. The Treasurer is responsible for keeping track of the club's budget and acting as the liaison to the finance committee. The Social Chair is in charge of organizing social events. The Keeper of the Flame is responsible for spirit during games and practices. The General Secretary is responsible for correspondence. The President shall act as team captain in games. The President shall also keep in contact with any appropriate league office. All officers will help coach the team in practice and in games. All officers must be Middlebury College Students.
- Article V. Elections
Elections shall be held by March 15 for offices to be held for the next academic year. A quorum of active members is needed to hold elections. Active members constitute those who attend practice regularly. Majority vote is 51%.
- Article VI. Meetings
Practices shall be held daily during the fall and spring. Games and tournaments will take place against area teams. Games and tournaments will take place in the fall and spring during the traditional water polo season.
- Article VII. Committees
There are no committees.
- Article VIII. Faculty Advisor
The membership recommends a member of the faculty/staff to advise the organization.

Article IX. Affiliations

The membership shall attempt to participate in the Eastern Water Polo League. Membership provides for tournaments during the fall and spring.

Article X. Ratification

- A. The constitution must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
- B. The constitution must be approved by the Student Government Association Constitution Committee.

Article XI. Amendment

- A. Amendments must be ratified by a two-thirds majority of the membership.
- B. Amendments must be approved by the Student Government Association Constitution Committee.
