

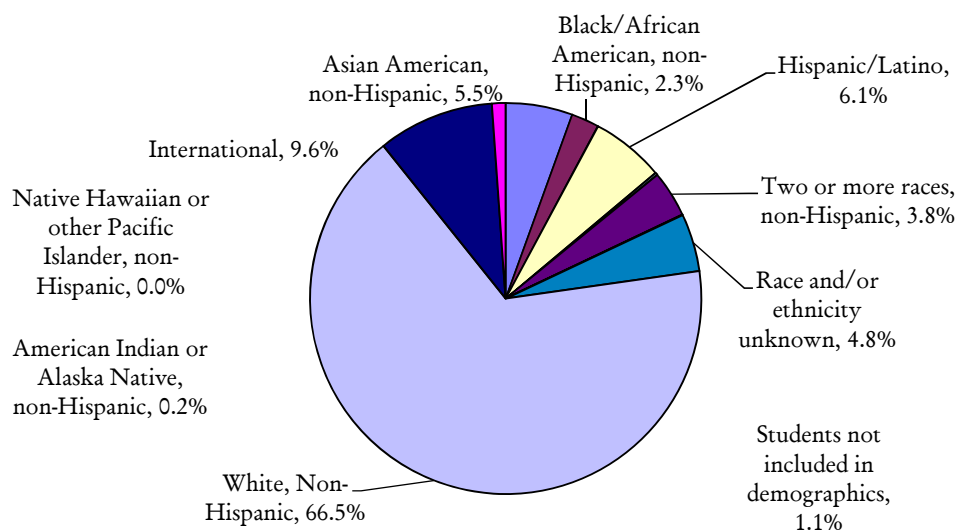
Fall Enrollment On-Campus

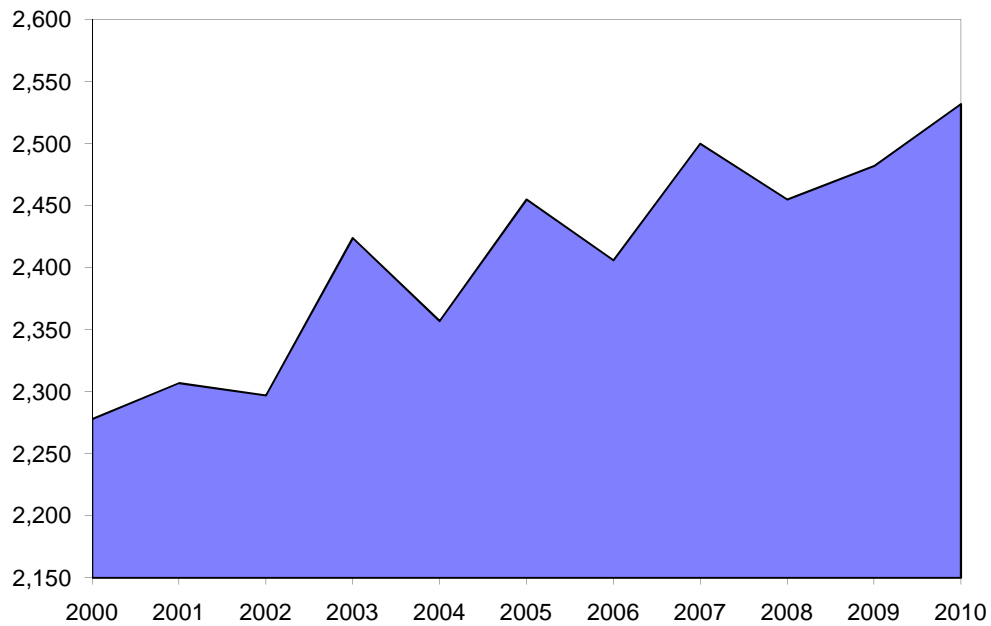
