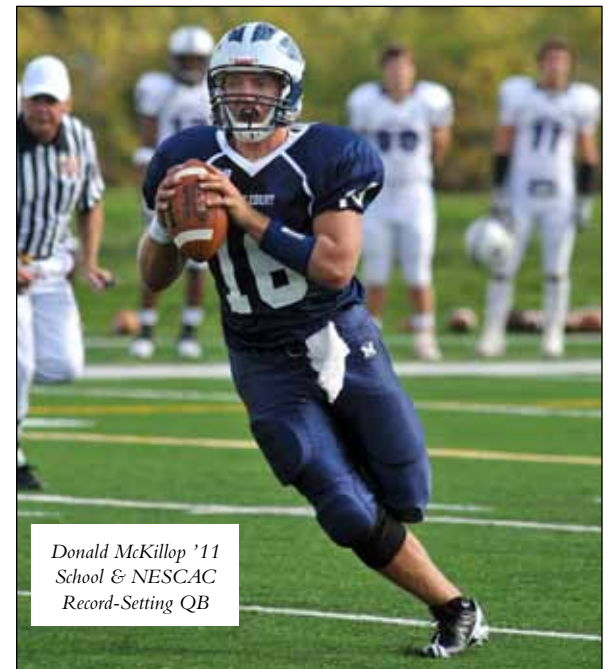
Head Coach
Bob Ritter



Bob Ritter, a 1982 Middlebury graduate, is entering his 12th season as head coach of the Panthers. Highlighting his 50–38 career record was his 2007 squad, which won the NESCAC Championship. In addition to the team title, Coach Ritter was selected as the NESCAC Coach of the Year. He also was chosen as the Region I AFCA Coach of the Year, becoming a finalist on for national Coach of the Year in 2007. In his time as a head coach, he has coached 74 All-NESCAC selections, while seeing his players re-write the record book. In the classroom, 77 players have earned All-NESCAC Academic honors, with several players garnering Academic All-Region honors since 2001.
