Biology Chemistry Environmental Studies Geology Physics Psychology	Student Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene (classroom)	Student workers/researchers from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Psychology and Physics who are college employees working in laboratories where chemical and/or physical hazards may be present	A prerequisite for employment or before a key/cardswipe access is issued
	Faculty/Staff Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene (classroom)	Faculty/staff from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics and Psychology who work in, or supervise work in laboratories where chemical and/or physical hazards may be present	As soon as practicable. This requirement (or the online Hazard Awareness training) is a prerequisite for the issuance of MBH cardswipe access/keys.
	Faculty/Staff Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene Refresher	Faculty/staff from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics and Psychology who work in, or supervise work in laboratories where chemical and/or physical hazards may be present	Within 2 years of completing initial Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene Training
	Field Safety (on-line) <a href="http://go/fieldtraining">go/fieldtraining</a>	Recommended for faculty/staff/students supervising field activities or performing unsupervised field work	Before leading a field activity or before performing unsupervised field work
	Laser Safety (on-line) <a href="http://go/lasertraining">go/lasertraining</a>	Recommended for faculty/staff/students who will be working with or issued keys to laboratories or classrooms where lasers will be used	As soon as practicable. This requirement will not be tied to the issuance of keys.
