

Kirk Alumni Center



Constructed in 1979 and named for John and Barbara Kirk, the Kirk Alumni Center is utilized for many College and public meetings, conferences, and a host of celebratory and social events. Pictured above is the Davis UWC 2013 Celebration Dinner. Situated adjacent to the Ralph Myhre Golf Course, the facility has expansive views of the College Athletic Complex and the Green Mountains.

With the encouragement and support of the President's Office, Kirk was renovated in phases during 2012 and 2013. The upstairs offices and storage rooms were converted to meeting spaces and the main floor was remodeled with the addition of new windows, new finishes and remodeled restrooms.

New kitchen equipment, including additional refrigeration, was installed and new furniture was provided throughout the building. The large exterior wrap-around deck was resurfaced and the exterior was repainted.
