

## Snow Bowl Maintenance Shop Ripton, VT



In December 2014, a new 2,400 square foot equipment maintenance and storage building for the Snow Bowl was completed. The new building replaces a metal building which reportedly was purchased at auction for \$1, disassembled, and relocated to the Snow Bowl in 1961.

The new building includes a Bully Lift which enables the staff to safely service and repair the grooming equipment – a task formerly performed outside in all seasons and weather conditions.

The building also allows for interior off-season equipment storage which will greatly increase the reliability and life-time of this very specialized and expensive snow grooming equipment.
