Biology Chemistry Environmental Studies Geology Physics Psychology	Student Lab Safety (classroom)	Student workers/researchers from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Psychology and Physics who will be issued keys to laboratories in which hazardous materials or processes may be present	Before a key is issued
	Faculty/Staff Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene (classroom)	Faculty/staff from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics and Psychology who will be issued keys to laboratories in which hazardous materials or processes may be present	As soon as practicable. This requirement will not be tied to the issuance of keys.
	Faculty/Staff Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene Refresher	Faculty/staff from the departments of Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Physics and Psychology working in laboratories or other work spaces where chemical and/or physical hazards are present	Within 2 years of completing initial Lab Safety/Chemical Hygiene Training
	Field Safety (on-line) go/fieldtraining	Recommended for faculty/staff/students supervising field activities or performing unsupervised field work	Before leading a field activity or before performing unsupervised field work
	Laser Safety (on-line) go/lasertraining	Recommended for faculty/staff/students who will be issued keys to laboratories or classrooms where lasers will be used	As soon as practicable. This requirement will not be tied to the issuance of keys.
	Formaldehyde Safety (on-line) go/formaldehydetraining	Recommended for faculty/staff/students who will be working with formaldehyde and/or paraformaldehyde products	Before commencing work. This requirement will not be tied to the issuance of keys
