Robison Hall at the Mahaney Arts Center is an intimate 370 seat concert hall that is ideal for acoustic and chamber music performances. In addition, it has the capacity to support appropriately sized amplified events.

The Concert Hall sound system is built around a Midas M32 digital soundboard and DL16 extension feeding a PowerMatch® PM8500 / PM8500N configurable power amplifier powering two Bose LT 9403 Full Range loudspeakers (onstage mains) and two clusters of Bose 317302-0200 MA12EX linear array loudspeakers (side/fill). This system provides clean and powerful coverage throughout the room. Four JBL EON self-powered speakers are available as monitors.
