

## **Eve Adler Memorial Fund for Summer Study in Classics/Classical Studies**

The fund is intended primarily to support students who wish, during the summer, to study Greek and Latin language, literature, and art, or to participate in archaeological field work at a Classical site. Priority will be given to Classics/Classical Studies majors and minors, but the fund is open to any student with a demonstrated purpose related to the field of Classics/Classical Studies.

The request for support should be accompanied by proof of application to a specific program or programs, or in the case of archaeological field work, by a signed statement from the supervising faculty member. Final decisions about funding are dependent on proof of acceptance to the program you intend to enter; the latter should be forwarded to the chair of Classics as soon as it becomes available. **N. B.** Awards typically to not exceed \$6,000.
