Courses:

Conducting (MUSC 0243)

In this course students will develop basic skills of conducting including movement, aural skills, creative gesture, and score study. Daily work will include preparation to conduct an ensemble of classmates. Proficiency in score reading is required.

Performing Ensemble Vocal Music (MUSC 0246)

Singing in an unaccompanied vocal ensemble enhances creativity, musicianship, and communication skills. Students will explore vocal technique, diction, performance practice, improvisation, and cultural context in a variety of vocal music. Students will select and perform repertoire for the course. Some score reading ability is required.

Singing Communities (FYSE 1347 First Year Seminar)

In this course, students will explore the role of vocal music in community and community building, by learning songs and studying why people sing them. Methodology includes learning, singing, discussion, community outreach, and individual research and writing projects.

Senior Seminar in Music (MUSC 0400)

Students develop their research and presentation skills and explore relevance through autoethnography, community engagement, music and identity, and artistic citizenship.

Fundamentals of Music Theory (MUSC 0160)

Open to all students without prerequisites. Students explore fundamental concepts in music theory, including notation, pitch relationships, harmony, and texture in music.
