Director (Comparative Literature Program)
Majors in Comparative Literature will develop a plan of study with the guidance of a faculty advisor with expertise in the students chosen primary language and literature, and the Director of the Comparative Literature Program.

The basic structure of the program is as follows:

1. One primary foreign language (your primary language can NOT be your native language, but it could be English) AND
2. Four courses of a secondary foreign language OR English/American Literatures (ENAM) OR your native language.
