3	<p>The purpose of the event and the applicant's rationale for attending the event are extremely clear. The submission form is completed thoroughly and the following parameters are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Essay is devoid of grammatical errors.</li><li>• Essay demonstrates explicit link between the event and the applicant's academic and career interests</li><li>• Essay explains how the event will support the student's interests and overall development.</li><li>• Essay clearly demonstrates how the student will communicate relevant/beneficial knowledge from the event with their program and the MIIS community</li><li>• If student is applying as a presenter, the application will also include a letter of invitation or other documentation of their presenter status.</li></ul>
2	<p>The purpose of the event and the applicant's rationale for attending the event are clear. The submission form is completed thoroughly and the following parameters are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Essay has one or two grammatical errors</li><li>• Essay demonstrates a link between the event and the applicant's academic and career interests</li><li>• Essay explains how the event will support the student's interests and overall development.</li><li>• Essay shows how student's participation in the event will benefit the overall MIIS community</li><li>• If student is applying as a presenter, the application will also include a letter of invitation or other documentation of their presenter status</li></ul>
1	<p>The purpose of the event and the applicant's rationale for attending the event are somewhat unclear. The submission form may contain <b>one or more</b> of the following issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Essay has several notable grammatical errors</li><li>• Essay vaguely explains how the event is related to the applicant's academic/career interests</li><li>• Applicant fails to explain how the event will benefit the MIIS community</li><li>• The length of the essay may detract from the student's explanation of their event</li><li>• Essay structure is unorganized or unclear</li><li>• Tone of writing is informal</li><li>• If student is applying as a presenter, the application fails to include a letter of invitation or formal documentation of their presenter status.</li></ul>
0	<p>The purpose of the event and the applicant's rationale for attending the event are extremely unclear. The submission form is incomplete and may contain <b>several</b> of the following issues::</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Essay has many grammatical errors that inhibit comprehension</li><li>• Essay does not prove the connection between the event and the applicant's academic/career interests</li><li>• Essay fails to demonstrate how the event will benefit the overall MIIS community</li><li>• The length of the essay significantly detracts from the student's explanation of their event (i.e. extremely short or long)</li><li>• Tone of writing is informal</li><li>• If student is applying as a presenter, the application fails to include any type of documentation of their presenter status.</li></ul>
