

**PROGRAM GOALS AND SCOPE:** By encouraging regular engagement with "the global," RGSP's goal is to equip select first-year students with a **global mindset** that will enhance their Middlebury education regardless of the majors they may ultimately declare. The program brings Scholars together to explore, accelerate, and deepen their understanding of complex global issues. It also positions them to appreciate the full range of **global educational and professional opportunities** that a Middlebury education offers. Each semester, the program will examine a particular theme. Last year's themes are *Human Rights/Women and Girls* (Fall) and *Our Planet, Our Future* (Spring).

**REQUIREMENTS:** To stay in the program and become certified, RGScholars must

1. attend all RGS weekly meetings in the fall and spring semesters;

2. explore the global by attending **4 events in the Fall (5 in the Spring)** and share reactions in their final

reflections. Events attended must have a global component or theme and events attendance will be **self-monitored.** Although events will be suggested, Scholars should feel free to curate their own global exploration journeys;<sup>1</sup>

3. fill out a short survey at the end of the Fall term that will monitor Scholars' progress;

4. write a **comprehensive reflection** piece (up to 1,000 words) at the end of the Spring term (guidance will be provided).
