## Middlebury College Measles Immunization Exemption Form for Summer Programs

Middlebury College’s immunization requirement for measles applies to short-term and graduate students enrolled in summer programs in Vermont. Before entry, students must provide documentation demonstrating immunity, unless exempt for medical or religious reasons. In order to claim either exemption, this form must be completed and returned to the College in advance of attendance.

Exemptions will not be accepted upon arrival.

Students who claim any exemption may be excluded at the discretion of the College. Due to the short-term nature of summer programs, students who are excluded will not be eligible to return to the in-progress program once excluded. No tuition refunds or credits will be issued in such cases. Excluded students may re-apply to the program for a future summer.

**Religious Exemption**

In signing this form I attest to holding religious beliefs opposed to measles immunization. I acknowledge that I have reviewed evidence-based educational material provided by my healthcare provider(s) and the Vermont Department of Health regarding immunizations including, but not limited to: information about the risks of adverse reactions to immunization; information that failure to complete the required vaccination schedule increases risk to the person and others of contracting or carrying a vaccine-preventable infection; and information that there are persons with special health needs who are unable to be vaccinated, or who are at heightened risk of contracting a vaccine preventable communicable disease, and for whom such a disease could be life-threatening.

All students with exemption are at risk from program exclusion and must submit a robust and realistic emergency departure plan in Banner. For an exemption to be approved, the following section must be completed to allow program staff to review submitted plans.
