MIIS Campus Security Resources and Tips

We want to remind you of a few important resources and tips to help keep you and our community safe. All attacks on our community are always taken very seriously by our security and residential life team.

At Munras, please do the following:

- Make sure doors shut securely behind you
- Do not let anyone inside the building that you do not know
- Escort guests at all times
- If you see something suspicious, report it (to security, a TA, a RA, Saiya, or a professor)
- Do not share your ID card or your door pin code with anyone
- Report if you have lost your ID card right away
- Look out for your fellow community members

When walking between Munras and campus, please do the following:

- Walk in groups.
- Avoid suspicious people, areas, and activities
- Carry a flashlight and a non-violent deterrent (mace, pepper spray, whistle, etc.)
- Be alert and aware of your surroundings
- Take off your MIIS ID and lanyard when not on campus

If you sense danger, please do the following:

- Move away from the threat. Cross the street and increase your pace
- Join a group of people or enter an open business establishment
- Keep valuables out of sights
- Do not display cash in a public area
- Report it
- Trust your gut

Additionally, we want you to know that you can always ask our security guards for an escort back to the residence hall. Although we cannot guarantee that a guard will be able to immediately accompany you, we can have a guard escort you safely back to Munras after making sure the campus is secure.

Our campus is also equipped with a handful of **blue** emergency phones. If you lift the receiver, our security department is automatically called. Emergency phones are located throughout the campus.
