

CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

for Public School Teachers

Scholarships: Created to celebrate the Middlebury Bread Loaf School of English's Centennial, these Centennial Scholarships provide broad support for public school teachers, with some awards designated specifically for those working in underserved schools and communities. Centennial scholarships provide funds supplemental to financial aid, up to the full cost of Bread Loaf summer study (two graduate courses) at the School of English in 2026.

Eligibility: All scholarship applicants must be full-time teachers in a public school, must have completed a minimum of one year of teaching by June 2026 and must be teaching during the 2026-27 academic year. Applicants must also apply both for admission (or re-enrollment) to the Bread Loaf School of English and for Middlebury financial aid.

Award notifications: Fellowship applications will be reviewed, and awards announced, in two rounds: the first in early March and the second in early May. Students who wish to be considered in the first round should submit their scholarship applications by February 16; those who wish to be considered in the second round should submit their scholarship applications by April 20.
