

COVID-19 TESTING IN MIDDLEBURY – Winter RECESS

For students who desire or require COVID-19 testing during the upcoming break, the following options are available in Middlebury:

1. Vermont Department of Health

The Vermont Department of Health offers COVID-19 testing at 154 Creek Road in Middlebury. Testing is available at the times listed below:

- Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
- Saturday 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.
- Please note: Hours may be subject to change and, due to increased prevalence of Covid-19 cases in the State of Vermont, pop up testing sites may be added. For the most accurate availability of testing please check the VT DOH [testing website](#)

Appointments are not required but can be [scheduled online](#) to avoid possible wait times.

2. Kinney Drugs

Kinney Drugs is conducting **asymptomatic** COVID-19 testing at numerous Vermont and New York locations. Available testing times vary by location and can be confirmed by visiting using their [Pharmacy Finder](#). The Kinney in Middlebury offers testing on:

- Wednesdays from 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

In both New York and Vermont, patients can schedule an appointment to get a COVID-19 test by selecting a state and following the [scheduling prompts online](#). At the appointment time, the patient will go to the drive-thru window to get a sample kit and perform a self-test. Partner labs will collect the samples, conduct the tests, and post results to their online portal. Results can be expected within 3-5 business days.

3. Porter Medical Center:

Porter Medical Center offers testing by appointment only at the Ambulatory Respiratory Clinic, on the main campus and **an order from a health care provider is now required**. Middlebury College's Health Services can provide this order. Call 802-443-5135 during Health Services business hours to request an order. Note: Health Services will be closed for the recess Dec 23rd – Jan 2nd. Health Services will reopen on Jan 3rd at 8:30 AM.

Testing at Porter is available:

- Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. - 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. - 4 p.m.

Once you have an order from a healthcare provider, call 802-388-8865 to schedule your testing appointment. Porter uses "My Chart" to send results electronically. If you do not have "My Chart" set up, you can ask them to set it up for you. Results can be expected within 1-3 business days.

For students who require transportation assistance from campus, contact [TriValley Transit](#) (TVT) to see if they have a route that will meet your needs.
