








• Click the Middlebury Retirement Program from the list.

• To contribute pre-tax,

- a. If you are contributing for the first time, click the **check box** next to Employee Contribution under MIDD Voluntary Retirement Plan 403b.
- b. If you are changing your contribution, click the **pencil** next to your current contribution amount under MIDD Voluntary Retirement Plan 403b.
