

Important Information for the 25th Reunion Class

Arrival and Check-In

Check-in for your class will begin at **4:00 p.m.** on Thursday, **June 6**. **Check-in will be at Atwater from 4:00 until 11:00 p.m.** You will receive your name tag (which serves as your meal ticket), an up-to-date schedule of events, your room key code if you are staying on campus, your Reunion souvenir, and any additional class or event information.

Whether or not you are staying on campus, you must check in at Atwater headquarters to get your registration packet and name tag. Walk-ins will be accepted for daily events. Unfortunately, we cannot provide housing for walk-ins.

We encourage you to arrive on Thursday to allow yourself time to get settled in and gather for our welcome dinner at Atwater Dining Hall. This table shows you where to check in throughout the weekend:

The Saturday night all-class dinner and reception is indeed the weekend highlight, featuring local alumni band the Grift! Your tents are located on the lower level, near the athletic fields. **Please wear your name tag to all meals.**
