

CITI Human Subjects Training Instructions


- 1) Go to: <https://www.citiprogram.org/>
- 2) At the top right, click “register”



- 3) On the next screen, click on “Select Your Organization Affiliation”



- 4) Type “Middlebury” under Select Your Organization Affiliation and select Middlebury College from the list



- 5) Click the checkboxes that appear to agree to the Terms of Service and to affirm that you are an affiliate of Middlebury college, then click “Create a CITI Program account.”

- 6) Enter all the required personal information and click through the steps to create a username and password.
- 7) You will be prompted to enter Middlebury specific information including your language preference and institutional email (@middlebury.edu email is recommended).
- 8) You will be prompted with the following options. This is one way to register for the correct course. **For IRB purposes, you need to select the first option “Yes, I conduct research...human beings.”** Feel free to also select other options that pertain to any other research activities you are engaged in.

9) On the next screen, you should select “Social & Behavioral Research Investigators:...” to enroll in the required course for IRB approval. Most research at Middlebury falls into this category. A small number of Middlebury researchers may fall into the biomedical research category. For these researchers, the Biomedical Research Investigators course may be most appropriate. Check with the IRB to confirm if you are unsure.
