

HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR THE 50TH REUNION CLASS

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN

Check-in for your class will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 5. You can go directly to your class headquarters in Forest Hall. There are three parking spots in front of Forest Hall where you can drop off your luggage. Student ambassadors will be there to help you manage your things and to direct you to the best place to park.

At your headquarters, you will get your name tag (which also serves as your meal ticket), an up-to-date schedule of events, a 50th gold ribbon for your cane, the code for your room if you are staying on campus, a class gift, and any additional class or event information.

Whether or not you are staying on campus, you must check in at your class headquarters to get your registration packet and name tag.

We encourage you to arrive as early as possible on Thursday to allow yourself time to get settled in and attend events in the morning with your class.

DORM HOUSING

Reunion Class of 1975 will be housed in Forest Hall, and your headquarters will be in the East Lounge. Most Forest rooms are set up with "sink mates" consisting of two singles with a connecting sink in between. Bathrooms are shared; no toiletries are provided. A pillow, sheets, a blanket, and a towel are provided. It may be helpful to bring things like an extra blanket, reading lamp, or small fan with you. Forest *does* have an elevator for getting to the upper floors.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND ASSISTANCE

PARKING

When you arrive on campus, please park only in designated faculty, staff, or visitor parking spaces. A few ADA-accessible spaces are also available for those with appropriate plates or permits. A parking pass for your car is included with this mailing; please complete it and place it on your dashboard when you park. If you forget to bring this pass, extras will be available at your headquarters in Forest Hall.

During drop-off times, you may unload your suitcases in front of Forest, but you may not leave your car there or in any designated "No Parking" area for an extended period. There is no long-term parking along College Street. During check-in, you will be directed to designated parking areas (Lots M and R), and shuttles will be available to take you back to your headquarters.

ON-CAMPUS TRANSPORTATION

Middlebury's beautiful campus can be a bit challenging to navigate. Please see the campus map included in this mailing, which shows shuttles circulating the campus on Friday and Saturday (marked with the red line). General transportation will be available, and we will also have vans and golf carts available for those who need assistance at other times. Please request transportation at your headquarters.

DINING

Meals will be provided throughout the weekend on campus from Thursday lunch through Sunday breakfast. Please wear your name tag to all meals.

On *Thursday* night, you will attend a surf and turf dinner with Interim President Stephen Snyder. After the event, there will be informal gathering time to reconnect in Forest Lounges.

Your *Friday* night festivities will be held up at Bread Loaf campus. Enjoy a reception, take your class photo, eat dinner, and move to the Bread Loaf barn for dessert and live music. Bus transportation from Adirondack Circle loads at 5:25 p.m. for a 5:30 p.m. departure.

Saturday night all classes will eat in the dining halls and enjoy a reception and music on Battell Beach. The Grift, a favorite Reunion Weekend band, will perform after dinner.

PACKING

Don't forget to pack your Gamaliel Painter's cane and **water bottle**, and do include your golfing and exercise gear if you plan to enjoy those activities.

The Thursday night reception with the interim president is the dressiest event—many men wear ties and jackets, and ladies wear dresses or pants. "Vermont casual" is the attire for the rest of the weekend; comfortable walking shoes are best. Remember to bring toiletries, layers, seasonal clothing, and in case of rain, waterproof shoes and a raincoat or umbrella.

Again, please pack a water bottle to use over the weekend; there are many water stations around campus for refilling bottles.
