

**Notice of the Filing of a
Labor Condition Application with the
Employment Training Administration**

1. An H-1B worker is being sought by The President & Fellows of Middlebury College through the filing of a labor condition application with the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor.
2. One (1) worker is being sought.
3. This worker is being sought as a full-time Executive Director of the James Martin Center for Nonproliferation Studies (a.k.a. CNS).
4. A wage in the range of \$147,735 to \$229,038 per year is being offered to this worker.
5. The period of employment for which the worker is sought is 01/01/2026 to 12/31/2028.
6. The employment will occur at CNS, 1400 K St. NW #1225, Washington, DC 20005.
7. The labor condition application is available for public inspection at the employer's principal place of business.

Complaints alleging misrepresentation of material facts in the labor condition application and/or failure to comply with the terms of the labor condition application may be filed with any office of the Wage and Hour Division, U.S. Department of Labor. H-1B employers are required to pay the higher of the "actual wage" or "prevailing wage."
