

Helpful Information for the 55th-75th Reunion Classes

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN

Check-in for your class will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, June 9. You can go directly to your class headquarters in Hepburn Hall. There you will get your name tag (which serves as your meal ticket), an up-to-date schedule of events, your room key if you are staying on campus, and any additional class or event information.

Whether or not you are staying on campus, you must check in at your class headquarters to get your registration packet and name tag.

We encourage you to arrive as early as possible on Friday to allow yourself time to get settled in and attend a few afternoon events before having dinner with your class. This table shows you where to check in throughout the weekend:

Note: Walk-ins will be accepted for daily events. Unfortunately, we cannot provide housing for walk-ins.

At headquarters in Hepburn, you can sign up for any class or Reunion event that requires preregistration. The Friday and Saturday campus bus tours require alumni to sign up in advance since space on each bus is limited. Please sign up when checking in on Friday or Saturday morning to make sure we don't leave without you. The tour guides will have check-in lists at the bus to be sure we have accounted for those who sign up. Please arrive five minutes before departure.

CLASS HOUSING AND HEADQUARTERS

Reunion classes 1948–1968 will be housed in Hepburn Hall, and your headquarters will be in Hepburn Lounge. Most dorm rooms consist of one or two single beds. Bathrooms are shared. A pillow, sheets, a blanket, and a towel are provided. It may be helpful to bring things like an extra blanket, reading lamp, or small fan with you. Hepburn does have an elevator for getting to the upper floors.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND ASSISTANCE

PARKING

When you arrive on campus, please park only in designated faculty, staff, or visitor parking spaces. A few ADA-accessible spaces are also available for those with appropriate plates or permits. A parking pass for your car is included with this mailing; please complete it and place it on your dashboard when you park. If you forget to bring this pass, extras will be available at your headquarters in Hepburn Lounge.

During drop-off times, you may unload your suitcases at Hepburn's circular drive, but you may not leave your car there or in any designated "No Parking" area for an extended period. There is no long-term parking along Hepburn Road. During check-in, you will be directed to designated parking areas, and shuttles will be available to bring you back to your headquarters.

Suggested parking areas for the 55th–75th Reunions include the Kevin P. Mahaney '84 Center for the Arts parking lot, on Old Chapel Road, behind Proctor Dining Hall (Hillcrest Road), and along College Street (Route 125) and Route 30.

ON-CAMPUS TRANSPORTATION

Middlebury's beautiful campus can be a bit challenging to navigate. Please see the campus map included in this mailing, which shows shuttles circulating the campus on Friday and Saturday (marked with the red line). Buses will be available on Saturday evening for transportation to and from the all-class dinner, and we will have dedicated vans and golf carts available for those who need assistance at other times. Please request transportation at your headquarters.

DINING

Meals will be provided throughout the weekend from Friday lunch to Sunday breakfast. Please wear your name tag to all meals.

On *Friday* night, you will have dinner with your class at one of the following locations (bus transportation will be available):

- 55th and 60th Reunion: Tourterelle in New Haven
- 65th-75th Reunion: Proctor Dining Hall, Woodstove Lounge

The Saturday night all-class dinner and reception is under the tents behind the Mahaney Arts Center. Your tent is on the side closest to the Mahaney Arts Center. Fireworks at dusk are followed by the Grift, a favorite Reunion Weekend band. Alumni headquartered in Hepburn are also invited to gather for social time in Hepburn Lounge on Saturday night, starting around 9:30 p.m.

PACKING

Don't forget to pack your cane and water bottle. While masks are not required now, consider packing one if you are more comfortable having one available.

Dinners are the dressiest events, with some men choosing to wear a jacket and women in dresses or pants. "Vermont casual" is the attire for the rest of the weekend; comfortable walking shoes are best. Remember to bring layers, seasonal clothing, and, in case of rain, waterproof shoes. Again, please pack a water bottle to use over the weekend; there are many places to refill your bottles around campus.
