<p>210</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This course is open to <u>all</u> students. No placement test required. No knowledge of Spanish, other Romance languages, or any other foreign languages required.</li> <li>• This course fulfills distribution requirement LNG, Foreign Language.</li> </ul>	<p>Accelerated beginning Portuguese. An intensive and fast-paced introduction to Portuguese, covering all of the basic structures and vocabulary as well as important aspects of the cultures of Lusophone countries.</p>
<p>215</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This course fulfills distribution requirement LNG, Foreign Language.</li> </ul>	<p>Advanced Portuguese. This course is a continuation of PGSE 0210. Students with previous knowledge of Portuguese may request a placement interview with a Portuguese professor.</p>
<p>300+</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PGSE 215 or instructor approval required.</li> <li>• One 300+ course required for study abroad in Portuguese-speaking countries.</li> </ul>	<p>These courses provide mainly culture content. They are taught in Portuguese and require/assess intermediate-advanced reading, writing, and speaking skills.</p>

#### Notes

**Language Study for IGS Latin American Studies:** Students who place into Spanish 0220 or above must take at least two semesters of Portuguese (0210 and above) to fulfill the language requirement. Students who place into Portuguese 0215 or above must take at least two semesters of Spanish (0105 and above) to fulfill the language requirement.
