4.1 ADMISSIONS

For Schools Abroad, nearly all students who apply to study on them are pre-screened and know whether they are qualified before applying. All Middlebury students who meet admissions criteria are admitted, and they normally do not apply if they are not qualified. In addition, since for practical purposes and in most sites, we are not limited in how many students we can accept, we do accept all qualified applicants from other institutions. 4.4 FACULTY

For Schools Abroad, students take courses in a variety of ways, usually either through direct enrollment in classes in our partner universities (alongside local students) or by faculty that we hire, normally on a part-time basis, at our Schools Abroad. Because they are not full-time faculty hired just for the purposes of teaching in the program during the program’s duration—as is the case for the vast majority of the faculty in all of our other programs—providing faculty counts and a student/faculty ratio would not have the same meaning as it does in other programs. For courses that we ourselves offer at Schools Abroad, small class size is the general rule of thumb.
