The 2025 conference runs from Sunday, June 15, 2025 to Saturday, June 21, 2025, with faculty arriving on Saturday, June 14, 2025. You will have responsibility for teaching a workshop, which will meet four times, conducting individual conferences (30 minutes) with your students, and giving a reading (up to 20 minutes).

In addition, we invite you to give a lecture and/or craft class. These two formats are especially popular with Bread Loafers and make up an essential part of the conversation that takes place on the mountain. Lectures are delivered in the Barn and faculty usually read texts of 45-50 minutes presenting some literary question or topic. Their attendance is conference-wide. Craft classes, also 50 minutes, are smaller, and as their name suggests, they are more hands-on or "craft" related (close reading of a text, writing or revision exercise, etc.) and are held in classrooms. We ask for your interest in offering a lecture or craft class via the online Faculty Information Form included on the [BL Translators' Faculty Page](#), and if we are able to add either or both to our roster, we pay additionally: \$1000 for a lecture; \$500 for a craft class.

Although the conference is not able to pay for travel expenses, room and board will be provided for you and for one person (spouse, partner or family member) sharing your room. If you would like to bring your family, we try our best to accommodate you in one of our campus houses or locate suitable accommodations nearby.
